The community Works Programme is an innovative offering from government to provide a job safety net for the unemployed people of working age. It provides a bridging opportunity for unemployed youth and others who are actively looking for employment opportunities. 3L development is contracted by the Department of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs to implement the programme in the Northern Cape area.

Through our procurement, we aim to empower local SMMEs as well as those owned by Historically Disadvantaged Individuals (HDIs). The purpose of this database is to give all prospective suppliers an equal opportunity to submit future quotations to 3L DEVELOPMENT. It is envisaged however, that this database will contribute to efficient administration and compliance with the PFMA.

In order to comply with the procedures, set out in the Accounting Officers Procurement Procedures (AOPP), as referred to in the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act 1 of 1999) (PFMA) and the National Treasury Regulations, 3L Development Supply Chain Management Department developed a supplier database to be used by the department in managing the procurement of various goods and services as required by the organisation from time to time.

Suppliers for the following Goods, Services, and training amongst others, namely:

1. Personal Protective Equipment (Trouser and Jackets, safety boots, dusk masks etc.)
2. COVID-19 Personal Protective Equipment
3. General Tools and Materials (Wheelbarrows, rakes, detergents, first aid kits etc.)
4. Agriculture inputs (Seeds, seedlings, pesticides, herbicides, hose pipes etc.)
5. Office equipment (Laptops, printers etc.)
6. Training courses (Both accredited and non-accredited service providers)
